

CCYSA Rules For ODSL/Travel Team Sponsorship Fall 2010

Any team wishing CCYSA to act as sponsor for a travel team **MUST** adhere to the rules within this document. While CCYSA has an obligation to support the growth of soccer in Clarke County, CCYSA will do so with the understanding that:

1. New teams must submit a written letter of application for sponsorship to CCYSA, at least 4 weeks prior to the ODSL registration deadline. Returning teams must notify CCYSA at least 2 weeks prior to the ODSL registration deadline of their intent to return and the level at which they will compete.
2. At least 60% of team members must reside in Clarke County.
3. CCYSA will have the ability to limit the number of teams, based on field availability.
4. Each travel team will pay \$250 per season to CCYSA for home field usage/upkeep, referee scheduling and administrative costs. This amount must be paid prior to the end of CCYSA regular season registration.
5. Field usage for games/practices will be scheduled through CCYSA's ODSL coordinator (ODSLcoordinator@clarkesoccer.org)
6. Referees will be obtained through the CCYSA Referee Coordinator (refcoordinator@clarkesoccer.org) by the ODSL coordinator.
7. Any person(s) coaching a travel team must (within 6 months) obtain a minimum of an "F" coaching license. Coaches & team managers must also register with KidSafe, prior to the start of each season.
8. Team contacts, policies, procedures and rosters will be provided to CCYSA before the ODSL deadline for submission.
9. Coaches, players, managers and parents represent CCYSA and must exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
10. CCYSA targets sponsorship of travel offerings 2 age ranges apart, to ensure that teams are not "cannibalizing" the same pool of players & to provide a team option to all ages (ex. if there is an U13, the next team in that gender should form at U11, not U12).

Failure to adhere to the above rules will result in the withdrawal of CCYSA support and sponsorship.
